Dear Bethlehem,

We have good news out of the 13 pastors we asked to interview- 6 have said yes. In the past I think the most who have ever wanted to interview from our list was 3. On the not so good side- I'm told that in the northwest district- 25% of our LCMS churches are without a pastor. Zion in Hillsboro and Prince of Peace in Bethany are also without pastors. So we're not alone. President Von Behren is aware of one of the issues causing this- salary guidelines for the northwest are about 20% less than the Midwest while we have a higher cost of living. He will be raising those guidelines over the next three years to entice more pastors to come.

I'm thankful the elders have stepped up to find pastors for us for the next few months and starting this Sunday will be leading us from time to time. They're also reaching out to those who are shut in and hospitalized. If you don't know who your elder is- talk to Ivan Weichbrodt who is our head elder or Mary Heck in the office.

This Sunday we say goodbye to long time members- Jim and Chris Cullen as they move to Montana. They've done a lot for us from teaching kindergarten and confirmation, helping call pastors, directed the choir, raised Kerry and Kevin here, ran capital campaigns, even helped run the pre-school and pre-school board. Then on the 12th we will be remembering Deedee Heyne and over 50 years spend here as a faithful member.

Children's ministry:

Sunday school has started up for those in pre-3 through 12th grade. Towards the end of this month and/or the start of September we will have auditions for our Christmas musical which will be on Dec. 14th- it's called Roadside Christmas Miracle and written by Ella Hoffman! Look for more details to come!

These folks remind us that Bethlehem is family. We are united in Christ and around His gifts of God's word, His sacraments, and also some gifts that we bring like coffee, donuts, and flowers each Sunday. We are united in this space and in the community for such a time as this. That has not changed.

Though we are in a time of transition leadership wise as a church, perhaps more so than usual Christ is seen as our leader. He works through this congregation from the 2 year old who cries through announcements to those needing canes and wheelchairs to get through the doors to those stuck at home watching online. You matter to this place and you matter to Jesus.

We are again joining with churches in our area to take part in "Operation Christmas Child" Last year Bethlehem members filled fifty-three boxes which went to Benin in

Africa and Guatemala in Central America. With several families making packing boxes a family event. We hope to fill even more this year and look forward to spreading God's word to more distant places. Boxes will remain available in the Narthex or Contact Greg Geist if you need more. Won't you help?

are also collecting shoebox items and cash. Note that it costs \$10 per box to cover shipping and overhead. We are planning to underwrite this year's program, but donations make the program sustainable and can be made to the office or offering plate identified for Operation Christmas Child. Bins for donation of items are in the Narthex.

This year's project will be completed the third week in November. Please return completed boxes to the church before then.

Advance planning is underway for this year's Christmas food box ministry. We will begin collecting food Thanksgiving with a packing event scheduled for Sunday, December 21st.


