For those wondering about our Operation Christmas Child boxes, all forty-one boxes sent from Bethlehem were shipped to our neighbors in Mexico. Thanks for supporting the Operations Christmas Child Ministry. For 2025, Operation Christmas Child delivered 12,205,900 shoebox gifts worldwide. We are looking forward to continuing our shoebox ministry in 2026. Building boxes throughout the year by collecting items when you can get them cheap or for free is the best way to maximize your gift. A flier showing when is the best times to get various shoebox items is posted in the fellowship hall. You can pack them one at a time when you have marshalled sufficient supplies. Boxes are available to fill all year—just ask.






